River Code

Many people enjoy the river. Please observe the following:

- Speed excessive speed through places where activities such as swimming, dinghy sailing, and fishing are taking place is dangerous and it can damage the saltmarshes. So please observe the relevant speed limits throughout the tidal length of the river as shown on the map inside.
- Boat Wash excessive boat wash is damaging to saltmarshes and river banks, and disturbing to those in moored/anchored boats.
- Noise noise can cause disturbance to wildlife, local inhabitants and to other visitors.
- Look out other river users may not be expert or may be undertaking complicated manoeuvres; please be prepared to take avoiding action even if you think you have 'right of way'.
- Litter please clean up after yourself and your dog.

There are few visitors moorings on the River Deben. Contact the Harbour Master or owner before leaving boat on mooring. Launching is by permission of the owners of the slipways.


