Treasurer's Report for year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023

The accounts reflect the fact that a number of good things happened over the year.

Starting with income which rose by about £500:

- membership number increased from 870 to 900
- we were lucky enough to benefit from a donation earlier in the year of some £250, which went towards cameras for otter spotting
- ticket sales to non-members for the autumn talk by Lord Deben paid for the venue and refreshments
- Interest rates increased, so interest income rose by over £200.

As for expenditure, that rose by £1150

- The main components were expenditure on the otter spotting project, the fish survey, and river fly survey. Reports from these activities appear either in the magazine or on the website.
- we succeeded in holding publication costs (the largest component of expenditure) at approximately the same level

Finally, we took advantage of the higher interest rates to invest £10000 in a 1-year bond at Capital and Counties bank. This will generate £500 in interest in 2024.

The mantra stays the same; save where we can, spend where we should to further the aims of the Association.
